FRESHWATER WETLANDS, STORMWATER, AND/OR WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION PERMIT TRANSFER

Note: Freshwater Wetlands Permits issued by the Rhode Island Department of Environmental Management that are active and recorded in the land evidence records of the municipality in which the subject property is located are automatically transferred upon the sale of the property to a new owner. If this is the case for your Freshwater Wetlands Permit, a Freshwater Wetlands Permit Transfer is not required. Expired permits cannot be transferred; a new permit application is required.
