## MONTHLY STATUS REPORT FOR JANUARY, 2019

On October 17, 2018, the Commission issued the Order Issuing Certificate (“Certificate Order”) issuing a certificate of public convenience and necessity to National Grid LNG LLC (“NGLNG”) in the above captioned docket for the Fields Point Liquefaction Project (the “Project”). *National Grid LNG LLC*, 165 FERC ¶ 61,031 (2018). Pursuant to Environmental Condition No. 8 of the Certificate Order, NGLNG provides its monthly status report for the month of January 2019.

### **Update on Federal Authorizations**

As previously reported in the report for December 2018, all required Federal authorizations have been received.

### **Project Schedule – Construction Status and Work Planned**

The overall project schedule was filed on December 21, 2018, as Attachment 19-2 to the request to proceed with pre-initial site preparation and a variance request.

1. NGLNG conducted perimeter air monitoring in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Rhode Island Department of Environmental Management (“RIDEM”) Short Term Response Action Plan approval dated October 27, 2017. NGLNG submitted perimeter air monitoring results to RIDEM on a weekly basis with the week of January 7, 2019 being the first reporting period.
2. The following site activity was completed in January 2019:
  - The demolition of the Former Propane Building.
3. The following site activity commenced in January 2019:
  - Wooden pile test pit investigation
4. The Environmental Inspector’s (“EI”) duties began this month with environmental-training for all involved hands. Site orientation training, including the requisite environmental training, was conducted for the workers working on the Project site, including all required National Grid personnel. This training will be ongoing for all new personnel for the full duration of the Project on a weekly basis and/or as needed.
5. The wood pile test pit investigation will continue into February, no other new work is planned on the site during the next reporting period.

### **Problems Encountered and/or Instances of Non-Compliance and Corrective Actions**

The problems encountered, contractor nonconformance/ deficiency logs, and each instance of noncompliance observed by the EI during this reporting period are shown below along with the corrective and remedial actions taken and the effectiveness of the implemented actions.
