

HOME FUELWOOD PROGRAM

This year, a total of 40 lots are available including 20 lots at the George Washington Management Area in Gloucester and Burrillville and 20 lots at the Arcadia Management Area in Exeter.

Arcadia Management Area

The way in which the lots are awarded to each bidder will be: lot numbers will be drawn randomly. As each is drawn, the highest bidder either accepts the lot or forfeits any chance for other lots in this home fuelwood program.

George Washington Management Area

The way in which the lots are awarded to each bidder will be: lot numbers will be drawn randomly. As each is drawn, the highest bidder either accepts the lot or forfeits that lot.

Woodlots will **NOT** be locked up at night and opened in the morning. The area will remain open and it is, therefore, advisable not to leave cut wood when you leave.

NO CUTTING WILL BE ALLOWED SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 8, AND SUNDAY NOVEMBER 9, 2008 DUE THE OPENING OF MUZZLE LOADING DEER SEASON ON STATE LANDS.

Management areas are closed at one-half hour after sunset by regulations. Violators may be fined.

TREES TO CUT: Arcadia Management Area: Trees to be cut are marked with blue paint.

George Washington Management Area: Trees to be cut are marked with red paint except lot 10 that is white paint and lot 18 that is blue paint.

MINIMUM BID: \$10 per cord
PLEASE NOTE THAT BIDS CAN BE MADE ON ANY OR ALL LOTS IF DESIRED, BUT ONLY ONE WINNING BID (LOT) WILL BE AWARDED PER HOUSEHOLD.

FILING FEE: \$1 per bid envelope, no matter how many lots are bid on. Bids submitted without the fee are disqualified. **BE SURE FEE IS IN BID ENVELOPE!!**
