Duties of the RI State Pilot Board (12/5/19)

Under 9.10 D.7 the State Pilot Board shall inform the Commission of the need for additional pilots.

Once an apprentice has been certified by the Commission, he/shall report to the Chairman of the State Pilot Board and complete the following: (under 9.10 E.2. Shall demonstrate swimming and treading water) be provided with all the requirements of (9.10 F. 1, 2, 3, & 4.) The Pilot Board Chair will report that all the above has been completed prior to the start of the apprentice training.

The Chair of the State Pilot Board shall insure that the following is complied with: 9.10 I. through K.

The State Pilot Board shall review the apprentice's evaluations on a quarterly basis and look for any potential problems. The State Pilot Board shall personally meet with each apprentice on a semi-annual basis and review the evaluations and grade the apprentice according to the regulations. This report grade shall be presented to the Commission on a semi-annual basis by the State Pilot Board Chair in writing. Unsatisfactory reports shall be made in person to the Commission.

Once the apprentice has completed the training as outline by the Commission regulations, the State Pilot Board shall present the Commission with written documentation as per 9.10 J.4. that the Board has certified apprentice for examination.
