Medical Form requirements policy. (Updated)

To all RI Full Branch and Probationary State Pilots:

Effective immediately, the Pilot Commission no longer requires that every pilot submit to the Commission a copy of the USCG 719k medical form on an annual basis. Each pilot must still, at all times, be in compliance with the federal regulations regarding medical certifications.

By December 31<sup>st</sup>, each pilot must still submit the RI Pilot Commission Medical form to the Commission which must be dated during the months of October, November, or December.

Any pilot who has become unable to perform the duties of a pilot due to an illness, accident, or elective surgery, for 30 days or more, must submit a new RI Medical form prior to returning to the rotation, completed by the same physician who filled out the previous one.
