Dear Ms. Curl,

The purpose of this letter is to inform you pursuant to the Industrial Property Remediation and Reuse Act (Rhode Island General Law 23-19.14-5) and the Remediation Regulations that additional investigation activities will be performed as part of the ongoing remediation of groundwater at the above reference property.

The purpose of the additional investigation activities is to develop additional data for on site conditions and to assess further remedial actions required to achieve RIDEM approved site groundwater remediation goals.

The additional activities include the following:

- Drilling of up to five (5) soil borings to the east of the former gasoline station using a direct push drill rig. During boring installation, soil samples will be collected to evaluate soil conditions and to collect samples for laboratory testing. Some or all of these soil borings will be completed as monitoring wells, depending on the results of field observations. The wells will be installed as 1inch diameter wells.
- Hydraulic conductivity testing at the proposed new wells. This testing will consist of pressurizing
 the well column to lower the water table and measuring how quickly the water level recovers after
 the pressure is relieved.

SCHEDULE

These activities may begin as early as October 13, 2007 and are anticipated to be conducted over an approximately two-week period.
