## NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT HEARING ON A SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT FACILITY LICENSE

In accordance with 23-18.9-9 of the Rhode Island General Laws, the Department of Environmental Management ("Department") announces its intent to issue a license to Newton B. Washburn, LLC to operate a Solid Waste Management Facility known as the **Newton B. Washburn, LLC Transfer Station** at 145 Shun Pike, in Johnston, Rhode Island.

An informational workshop on this facility will be held in Room 300 of the DEM headquarters building at 235 Promenade Street, Providence, R.I. on **March 24, 2017** at 12:30 PM. Representatives of the Department will be available to discuss the proposed facility, the type and quantity of wastes to be processed, a summary for the basis of the draft license, proposed conditions to be placed on the license, and a description of the procedures for reaching a final decision on the license application. The discussion of administrative procedures shall also include the beginning and ending period for public comment, the address where comments will be received, information on the public comment hearing, any other procedures by which the public may participate in the final decision, and the contact person for further information.
