I am requesting an extension of the comment period on the draft Five Year Review of the Springfield Street Schools site through and including February 15, 2012. This request is made to enable our technical assistance provider, SKEO Associates, to complete their review of the Five Year Review and draft comments on the document that we will submit to DEM. As you know, EPA provided SKEO Associates through it's Technical Assistance Services for Communities (TASC) Program. My clients made a request for TASC Services more than a year ago, and EPA was unable to grant this request until earlier this month. SKEO is already reviewing the draft 5 Year Review and other documents in the on-line document repository, and plans on making a site visit later this week. Nonetheless, SKEO requires an additional 30 days to complete their review.
