As requested by RIDEM, the following summarizes response actions expected to be performed at the above-referenced site during the week of July 4, 2011.

## SITE ACTIVITIES TO BE PERFORMED

- Complete site observation walk;
- Begin shallow excavations within the natural gas regulator station area to isolate gas utilities and install electrical conduit; and
- Perform air monitoring during excavation activities in accordance with the April 2011 Air Quality Monitoring Program (AQMP).

Due to a delay, no activities were performed in the natural gas regulator station area during the week of June 27<sup>th</sup>. The work described above is anticipated to begin on July 5<sup>th</sup>. We currently anticipate that trenching activities associated with undergrounding the overhead natural gas line will not begin before the week of July 11<sup>th</sup>.
