As requested by RIDEM, the following summarizes response actions expected to be performed at the above-referenced site during the week of August 8, 2011.

SITE ACTIVITIES TO BE PERFORMED

- Complete site observation walk;
- Continue shallow excavations within the natural gas regulator station area to isolate gas utilities;
- Perform trenching associated with undergrounding the overhead gas line near the regulator station; and
- Perform air monitoring during excavation activities in accordance with the April 2011 Air Quality Monitoring Program (AQMP).

Subsequent to the completion of the excavation work, certain above-ground activities (i.e., no excavation work) associated with the regulator station upgrades will be performed at the site.
