On behalf of National Grid, the following summarizes response actions to be performed at the abovereferenced site during the timeframe from September 3 to 14, 2012.

## SITE ACTIVITIES TO BE PERFORMED

Complete site observation walk. •

Earthwork associated with the proposed electrical substation upgrades is currently anticipated to begin the week of September 17, 2012. Air monitoring will be performed during the earthwork activities as described in GZA's February 20, 2012 Evaluation of Applicability of Air Pollution Control Regulation No. 9 submittal to the RIDEM Office of Air Resources and GZA's subsequent correspondence with RIDEM dated June 14, 2012 and July 27, 2012. On July 5, 2012, RIDEM issued a letter stating that an air permit for these proposed earthwork activities would not be required.

Replacement of the meter building associated with natural gas regulator station is currently planned for mid October 2012. This work consists of aboveground work and will not involve soil excavation.
