On behalf of National Grid, the following summarizes response actions to be performed at the above-referenced site during the timeframe from July 15 to 19, 2013.

## SITE ACTIVITIES TO BE PERFORMED

• Complete site observation walk.

Field work to install the probes associated with the soil gas quality survey was completed between July 8 and 11, 2013. During the soil gas probe installation, ambient air monitoring was performed consistent with the May 2013 SSIWP. This monitoring included Total Volatile Organic Compounds (TVOCs) and particulate dust in the work zone perimeter. No transient or sustained threshold values were noted for either TVOCs or dust during the air monitoring this past week. The air monitoring data will be posted on the National Grid website and the site bulletin boards by Monday.

It is currently anticipated that the probes will be sampled during the week of July 22, 2013.
