## SITE ACTIVITIES TO BE PERFORMED

- Continue demolition activities associated with three on-Site buildings (the former machine shop, purifier house and the meter room). The process is expected to be complete by August 28<sup>th</sup>. National Grid will have a representative on-site who will monitor the work and conduct air monitoring throughout the demolition project. The air monitoring will be consistent with the site-specific, Rhode Island Department of Environmental Management (RIDEM)-approved Air Quality Monitoring Plan that includes a two-tiered approach during intrusive activities.
- Complete quarterly NAPL gauging round and collection of soil gas sample at SG-105S.
- Complete bimonthly Site observation walk during week of July 27, 2015 to July 31, 2015.
