The following summarizes response actions completed at the above-referenced site for the period September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2016 through September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2016, as well as planned activities.

## SITE ACTIVITIES PERFORMED

- Performed Site visits to document security conditions and sheen observations, if present.
- The stormwater system repair and restoration of the South Washout Area was completed on August 26<sup>th</sup>, 2016. A STRA Completion Report for this activity was submitted to RIDEM on September 26<sup>th</sup>, 2016. The mailing list was also notified (via email) of the availability of the STRA Completion Report on August 26<sup>th</sup>, 2016.
- The City of Pawtucket completed transportation of excess soils to the Tidewater Site from their Max Read Field reconstruction project on September 27<sup>th</sup>, 2016.

## FUTURE RESPONSE ACTION WORK/SCHEDULE

- Continue quarterly Non-Aqueous Phase Liquids (NAPL) monitoring and recovery. The next event is scheduled for October 2016.
- Continue annual groundwater sampling. The next event is scheduled for October 2016.
- Continue Site visits to document security conditions and sheen observations.
