

Summary of Initial Community Meeting

This document has been prepared to summarize the Initial Community Meeting held by National Grid on July 26, 2017 between 6 PM and 8 PM at the International Charter School. Consistent with the Public Involvement Plan (PIP) established for the Site, National Grid held this Initial Community Meeting to provide additional information regarding the Site investigation, planned limited design investigations, planned remediation, and RIDEM's Site Remediation Program, and to further engage in dialogue with the community about the Site. The City of Pawtucket also participated in this meeting and displayed their conceptual future use plan for the northern portion of the Site. This meeting was a poster board session which allowed for dialogue with community members on past and upcoming project work.

The following is a response to a written comment received during this meeting.

Question 1: Comment: Carolyn Sheehan, Blackstone Academy. "We are excited about all of the potential public access and hope things can go forward quickly. Once we all know the timeline of remediation, we will be able to provide more feedback."

Response 1: National Grid appreciates your feedback and participation at the Initial Community Meeting held on July 26, 2017. As described during this meeting, the project is moving to the remedy design, permitting and implementation phase. The next steps include National Grid's performance of a Limited Design Investigation (LDI) and RIDEM's issuance of a Remedial Decision Letter (RDL). The RDL serves as RIDEM's approval of the proposed remedy and typically sets the timeframe for preparation and submittal of the Remedial Action Work Plan (RAWP). The LDI is designed to provide additional data necessary to prepare the RAWP.

We currently anticipate the LDI work will be performed in fall 2017/early winter 2018 and the RAWP will be submitted to RIDEM within 12 months of receipt of the RDL. Subsequent to submittal of the RAWP to RIDEM, National Grid will hold a Community Meeting to present the RAWP along with an anticipated remedy implementation schedule.
