## SITE ACTIVITIES PERFORMED

• GZA performed bi-weekly Site visits to document security conditions and sheen observations, if present.

## **FUTURE RESPONSE ACTION WORK/SCHEDULE**

- Continue Site visits to document security conditions and sheen observations.
- Performance of a geotechnical investigation program by BETA as part of the Narragansett Bay Commission's Phase III Combined Sewer Overflow upgrade project which started the week of September 2, 2019 and is intended to be completed the week of September 9, 2019. GZA will provide periodic oversight of the investigation program and will be posting and uploading air monitoring results to the bulletin boards and the project website.
- Performance of invasive plant species management activities within the upland portions of the Site the week of September 16, 2019 consistent with a CRMC Assent.
- Performance of an annual groundwater monitoring event.
