OUTDOOR RECREATION GRANT PROGRAM

This grant program, funded through **state bond funds**, provides matching dollars to municipalities and native American tribes for the **acquisition**, **development and renovation** of outdoor recreational lands and facilities.

Since the inception of DEM's Outdoor Recreation Grant program in 1988, **541 grants** have been awarded and **over \$85 million invested** in improvements in all 39 Rhode Island communities.



FY 2022 SNAPSHOT

- 12 projects completed with \$2.3m in state funds
- 16 new grants awarded with \$4m in state funds
- 26 active grants currently under construction - funded with \$4.9m of state dollars
- Total Activity \$11.2m
