SECURE FACILITIES:

DCR OFFICE

- 1. Store all files computers, copiers, faxes, etc. at Fishermen's Memorial State Park.
- 2. Store all office stationary, etc. in the attic of the Office.
- 3. Turn off electricity and water.
- 4. Sandbag all entrances.

DCR WORKSHOP

- 1. Store all power tools, including gas-powered equipment at Fishermen's Memorial State Park.
- 2. Fuel all vehicles and store them at Fishermen's Memorial State Park.
- 3. Fill all reserved fuel containers and store them at Fishermen's Memorial State Park.
- 4. Load work boat on trailer and store it at Fishermen's Memorial State Park.

GENERAL AREA.

- 1. Check with boat owners and Captains for available dock spaces.
- 2. Hand out emergency passes to business, boat owners and boat capitans to enter the Port after the storm.
- 3. Plug all inlet holes in 1,000-gallon waste-oil tanks.
- 4. Seal all oil filter barrels and load them on a vehicle covered with canvas. Store it at Fishermen's Memorial State Park.
- 5. Store all floatable objects in compound.
- 6. Remove ramps to floats.
- 7. Turn off electricity and water at meters.
