Dear Mr. Sciaba:

The Rhode Island Department of Environmental Management's (the Department) Office of Waste Management (OWM) has received your March 24, 2010 correspondence requesting to disturb the cap to perform electrical work. The Notice indicates that all site work will be completed and managed in accordance with the Post-Remediation Soil Management Plan (SMP) and recorded Environmental Land Usage Restriction (ELUR) for the property.

Since the excavation area is currently capped with clean soil, please segregate the top foot of soil for the excavation separately from the rest of the excavated soil beneath. Upon completion of the subsurface work, backfill the soil that was at depth first and cap it off with the top foot of clean soil.

In accordance with the SMP and following site work, please submit a Closure Report to the Department briefly describing the work performed and providing photographs of the approved work as well as copies of all disposal documentation, if any. If these described remedial actions generate any excess soil for offsite disposal, the soil must be disposed of at a licensed disposal facility and copies of the disposal records included in the Closure Report.
