This letter is to serve as clarification concerning the disposition of the solid waste material being generated and screened at the Springfield Street School Site in Providence. All solid waste materials generated, as part of this project, including the screened material piles, must be disposed of at a licensed solid waste facility. As the Department has stated to the City and O. Ahlborg & Sons representatives on several occasions, any material excavated, generated or created as a result of this screening process is solid waste by definition and **cannot** be re-interred on this site. If any evidence of this activity is brought to the attention of the Department, further enforcement will be implemented against any or all of the responsible parties.
