The following summarizes response actions completed at the above-referenced site for the period May 1, 2015 through May 31, 2015, as well as planned activities.

## SITE ACTIVITIES PERFORMED

- Performed Site visits to document security conditions and sheen observations, if present.

## FUTURE RESPONSE ACTION WORK/SCHEDULE

- Continue quarterly NAPL monitoring and recovery and limited soil gas sampling. The next event is scheduled for July 2015.
- Continue Site visits to document security conditions and sheen observations.
- Mobilize and begin demolition activities associated with three on-Site buildings (the former machine shop, purifier house and the meter room) in June 2015. Mobilization is anticipated to start on June 18<sup>th</sup> with demolition-related work starting June 23<sup>rd</sup>. The process is expected to be complete by August 28<sup>th</sup>. National Grid will have a representative on-site who will monitor the work and conduct air monitoring throughout the demolition project. The air monitoring will be consistent with the site-specific, Rhode Island Department of Environmental Management (RIDEM)-approved Air Quality Monitoring Plan that includes a two-tiered approach during intrusive activities. A fact sheet with more information regarding this work will be posted and sent to the email distribution list the week of June 8<sup>th</sup>.
