The following summarizes response actions completed at the Former Tidewater Facility for the period April 1 through April 30, 2018, as well as planned activities.

SITE ACTIVITIES PERFORMED

- Performed Site visits to document security conditions and sheen observations, if present.
- A subcontractor engaged by National Grid cleared a fallen tree to allow access to a monitoring well cluster on April 25, 2018.
- Performed the second 2018 quarterly NAPL monitoring and recovery round between April 17 and 18, 2018.

FUTURE RESPONSE ACTION WORK/SCHEDULE

- Continue Site visits to document security conditions and sheen observations.
- Preparation of a draft Remedial Action Work Plan in response to the April 19, 2018 Remedial Decision Letter.
- Complete one geotechnical boring between May 3 and 4, 2018. This boring will be performed directly east of the substation to collect geotechnical information for the design of a new control house being constructed as part of future substation upgrades.
- Continue quarterly NAPL gauging and recovery activities. The next event is scheduled for July 2018.
