Application for 100% Permanent Disability Fishing/Combination License

Eligibility Requirements:

Persons with Disability who are 100% Permanently Disabled and are eligible for a Fishing/Combination License, are required to present the ORIGINAL DOCUMENT OF THE FINAL DECISION(S), on Agency letterhead, from the Social Security Administration for a Fishing/Combination License. Instead of the above documentation, DEM will accept a current disability beach pass (disability picture ID) from the RI, DEM Parks & Recreation Division. For a hunting license, the applicant MUST provide a prior RI hunting license or a current or prior OUT OF STATE hunting license, a hunter safety card from any state, or an Honorable Discharge (DD-214) and present the ORIGINAL DOCUMENT OF THE FINAL DECISION(S), on Agency letterhead, from the Social Security Administration. THIS LICENSE, ONCE ISSUED IS VALID FOR A ONE YEAR LICENSE PERIOD, EXPIRING YEARLY THE LAST DAY OF FEBRUARY. In future years, persons with disabilities must provide the division with the original document of the final decision(s), on Agency letterhead, from the Social Security Administration that indicates the continuing nature of the permanent disability. NOTE: EXPLANATION OF BENEFIT LETTERS DO NOT APPLY.

Veterans: In order to be determined to be eligible for a 100% Permanent Disability Fishing/Combination License, applicants are required to present the ORIGINAL DOCUMENT OF THE FINAL DECISION(S), on Agency letterhead from the Department of Veteran Affairs for a fishing license. For a hunting license, the applicant MUST also provide a prior RI hunting license or a current or prior OUT OF STATE hunting license, a hunter safety card from any state, OR AN Honorable Discharge (DD-214). THIS LICENSE ONCE ISSUED IS PERMANENT. NOTE: EXPLANATION OF BENEFIT LETTERS DO NOT APPLY.

WARNING

Rhode Island General Law § 20-13-5 **PROHIBITS** the following persons from **PURCHASING** or **POSSESSING** a Hunting License:

- Persons convicted of a crime of violence*
- Fugitives from Justice
- Anyone declared Mentally Incompetent
- Drug Addicts
- Habitual Drunkards

* "Crime of Violence" shall mean and include any of the following crimes or an attempt to commit any of them; murder, manslaughter, rape, first or second degree sexual assault, first or second degree child molestation, kidnapping, first and second degree arson, mayhem, robbery, burglary, breaking and entering, any felony involving the illegal manufacture, sale or delivery of a controlled substance classified in schedule I or schedule II of **21-28-2.08**, any violation **21-28-4.1** or **21-284.01.2** or conspiracy to commit any violation of these statutes, assault with a dangerous weapon, assault or battery involving grave bodily injury, and or assault with intent to commit any offense punishable as a felony; upon conviction of an offense punishable as a felony offense under 12-29-5 (domestic violence).

Penalty is a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not more than five-hundred dollars (\$500.00) or imprisonment for up to ninety (90) days or both.
